Thank you for being there with us through all of the challenges and changes. Even as the pandemic tested our limits, not only did we have faith that you would be there with us, but we knew we would find new friends and supporters to make sure we could continue to serve and support those most vulnerable in our community and you did not let us down.

In Fiscal Year 2022, we saw a number of programmatic changes that were the beginning of a revitalization leading into our strategic planning. 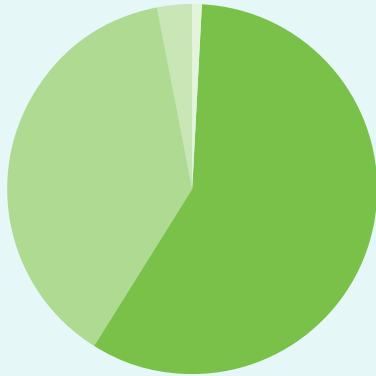

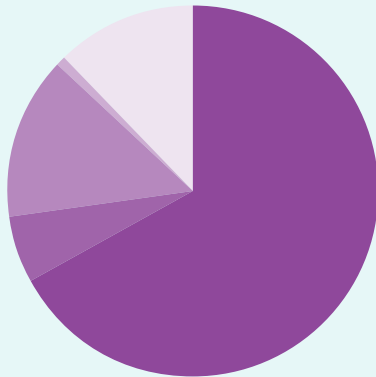
